Overview:

From 2004 to 2008, Belize's exports increased on average by 8.7 percent each year and amounted to 295.1 mln US\$ in 2008 (see table 1). During the same period, imports increased on average by 12.9 percent each year to 836.5 mln US\$ in 2008 (see table 2). This resulted in a trade deficit of 541.4 mln US\$ in 2008 (see graph 1). By MDG regions, the trade balance recorded a surplus amounting to 29.0 mln US\$ with Developed Europe (see graph 2). Large deficits were recorded with Latin America and the Caribbean (-307.3 mln US\$) and Developed North America (-159.2 mln US\$). Both imports and exports were concentrated among a few partners: 3 (respectively 7) major partners accounted for 80 percent of exports (respectively imports) (see graph 3).

Graph 1: Total imports, exports and trade balance



Exports Profile:

In 2008, food, live animals, beverages and tobacco (SITC sections 0+1) accounted for the majority of exported goods representing 57.3 percent of total exports (see table 1). Exports of mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (SITC section 3) increased by 64.0 percent and represented 40.3 percent of exports. Top partners for exports in 2008 were the USA, the United Kingdom and Costa Rica (see table 4). Exports to the United Kingdom were exclusively food, live animals, beverages and tobacco (SITC sections 0+1) while exports to Costa Rica were exclusively mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (SITC section 3). Top products for exports from 2006 to 2008 included petroleum oils, crude (HS code 2709), fruit juices (including grape must) and vegetable juices (HS code 2009) and cane or beet sugar and pure sucrose, in solid form (HS code 1701) (see table 3).



Graph 3: Partner concentration of trade in 2008



Imports Profile:

In 2008, Belize's imports were composed of 22.4 percent of commodities and transactions not classified elsewhere (SITC section 9), 21.0 percent of machinery and transport equipment (SITC section 7) and 16.2 percent of mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (SITC section 3). From 2006 to 2008, major products for imports were petroleum oils, other than crude (HS code 2710), motor vehicles for the transport of goods (HS code 8704) and motor cars and other motor vehicles principally designed for the transport (HS code 8703) (see table 5).
