
## Imports: CIF, by origin

## Overview:

After several years of continuous growth marked by a peak of 49.5 bln US\$ in 2008, the value of the exports of Romania dropped in 2009 (by 18.0 percent) but bounced back in 2010 by 21.6 percent to amount to 49.4 bln US\$ slightly below the peak reached in 2008 (see table 1 and graph 1). Imports showed a similar development with an increase by 14.3 percent to 62.0 bln US\$ in 2010. This resulted in a trade deficit of 12.6 bln US\$, slightly lower than the 2009 deficit of 13.6 bln US\$ (see graph 1). Large deficits were recorded with Developed Europe (-9.0 bln US\$), Eastern Asia (-3.4 bln US\$) and Commonwealth of Independent States (-3.0 bln US\$) (see graph 2). Trade recorded a surplus of 2.2 bln US\$ with Western Asia. Exports were more diversified across partners than imports: in 2010, 17 major partners accounted for 80 percent of exports compared to 15 major partners for imports (see graph 3).

Machinery and transport equipment (SITC section 7) accounted for most of exports (41.9 percent) in 2010 (see table 1). Other important commodity groups included manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (SITC section 6) and miscellaneous manufactured articles (SITC section 8) respectively with 16.9 and 15.3 percent. In 2010, Germany, Italy and France were the three largest markets for exports: they accounted for nearly 40.2 percent of exports (see table 4). Major commodities for exports included petroleum oils, other than crude (HS code 2710), insulated (including enamelled or anodised) wire, cable (HS code 8544) and parts and accessories of the motor vehicles of headings 87.01 to 87.05 (HS code 8708) (see table 3).



## Graph 3: Partner concentration of trade in 2010



## **Imports Profile:**

Machinery and transport equipment (SITC section 7) and manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (SITC section 6) accounted for large shares of imports: respectively 34.4 and 21.2 percent in 2010 (see table 2). Over the last three years, top imported products were petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals, crude (HS code 2709), medicaments (excluding goods of heading 30.02, 30.05 or 30.06) (HS code 3004) and motor cars and other motor vehicles principally designed for the transport (HS code 8703) (see table 5).
